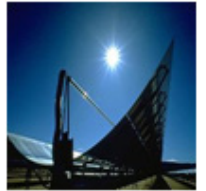
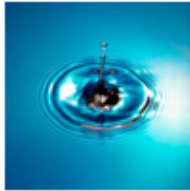




Green Energy and its Challenges
