Experts from Austria and Romania will contribute to tracing the social dynamics from the after World War II period until Nicolae Ceaușescu's establishment as head of the country. upon Margarete Schütte-Lihotzky's projects, Abbé Libansky who will speak about how propagandistic art stole the ideas from modern art, Anna Soucek with a lecture entitled *Rebellen auf Wellen* (Rebels on the waves), Jan Tabor who will debate about the faith of artistic positions in Czechoslovakia, with a focus on Milada Horakova. *People and revolutions* is part of a larger project entitled *Art and Liberation.
